Talk to you local **municipality**. Ask them:

- how they nominated the parcels to be part of the claim
- how the identified parcels fit within the Official Plan, Zoning bylaw – what will the zoning of the parcel(s) be? Permitted uses? Density?
- what consideration was given to rights of access, impacts on existing (private and public) infrastructure
