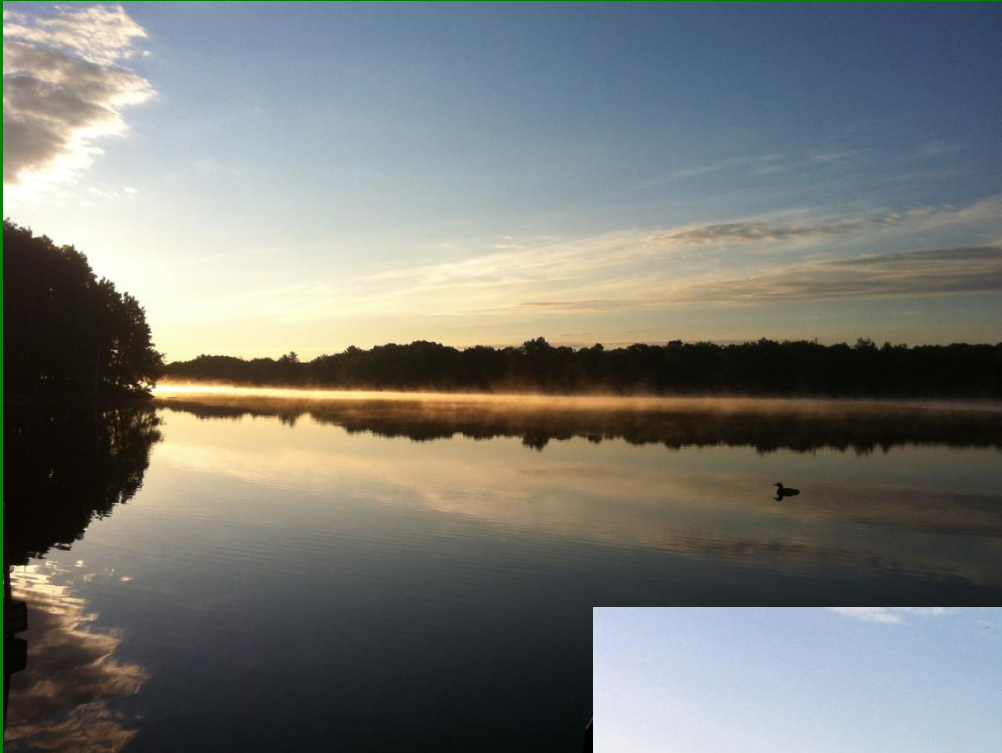
Thriving & Sustainable Waterfronts

Recreational Lake Development (road access and “discovery”)

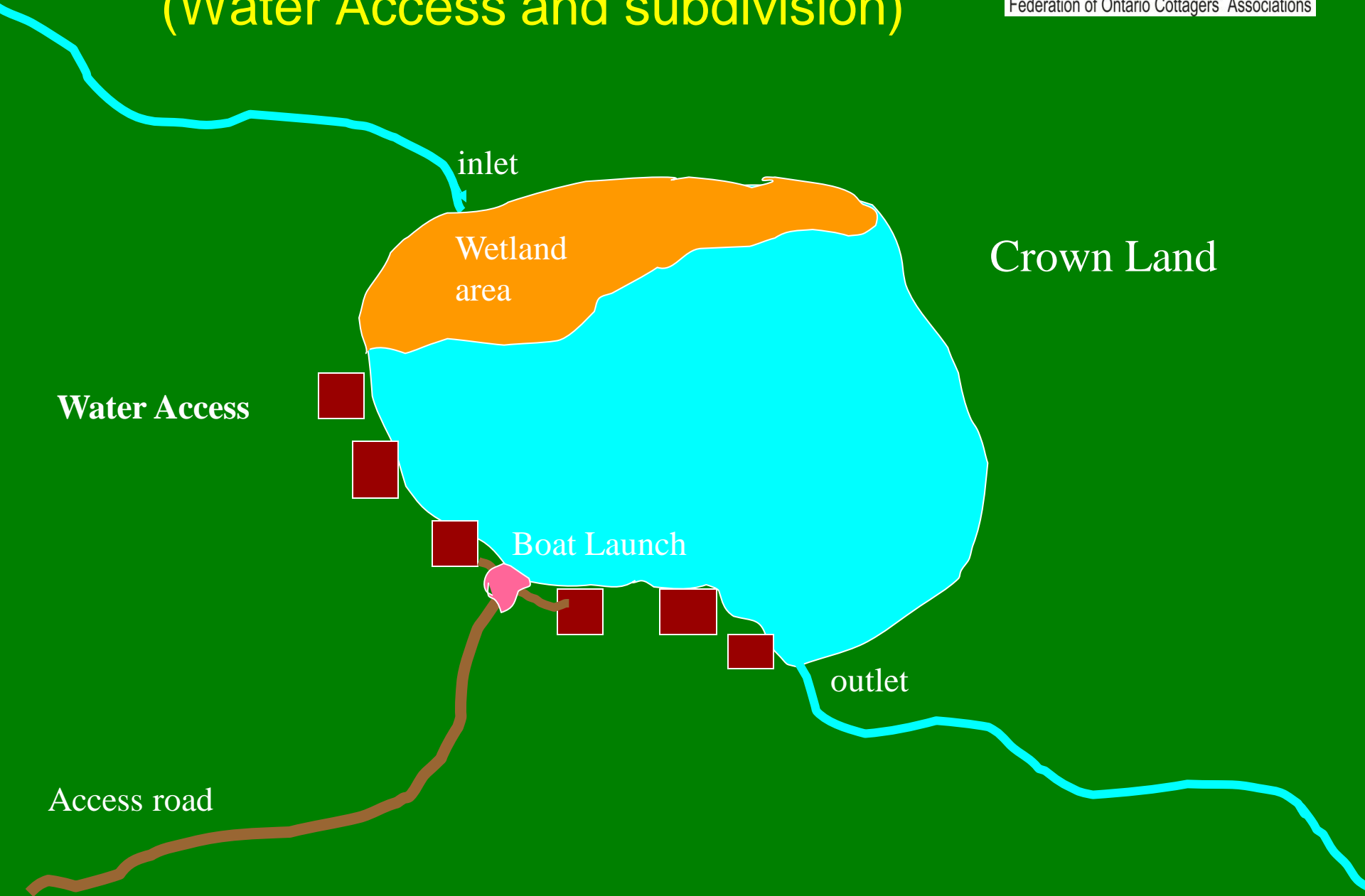




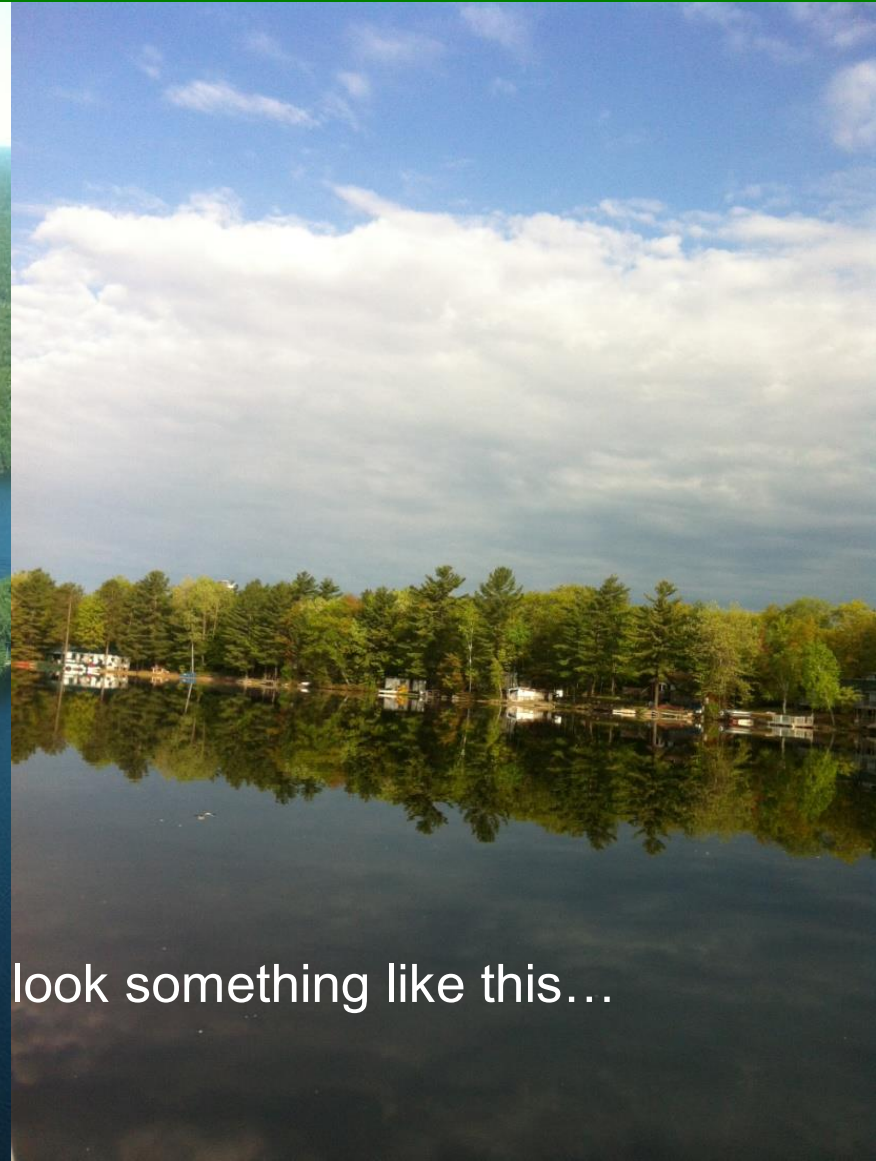
...which might look

Low density, still mostly natural

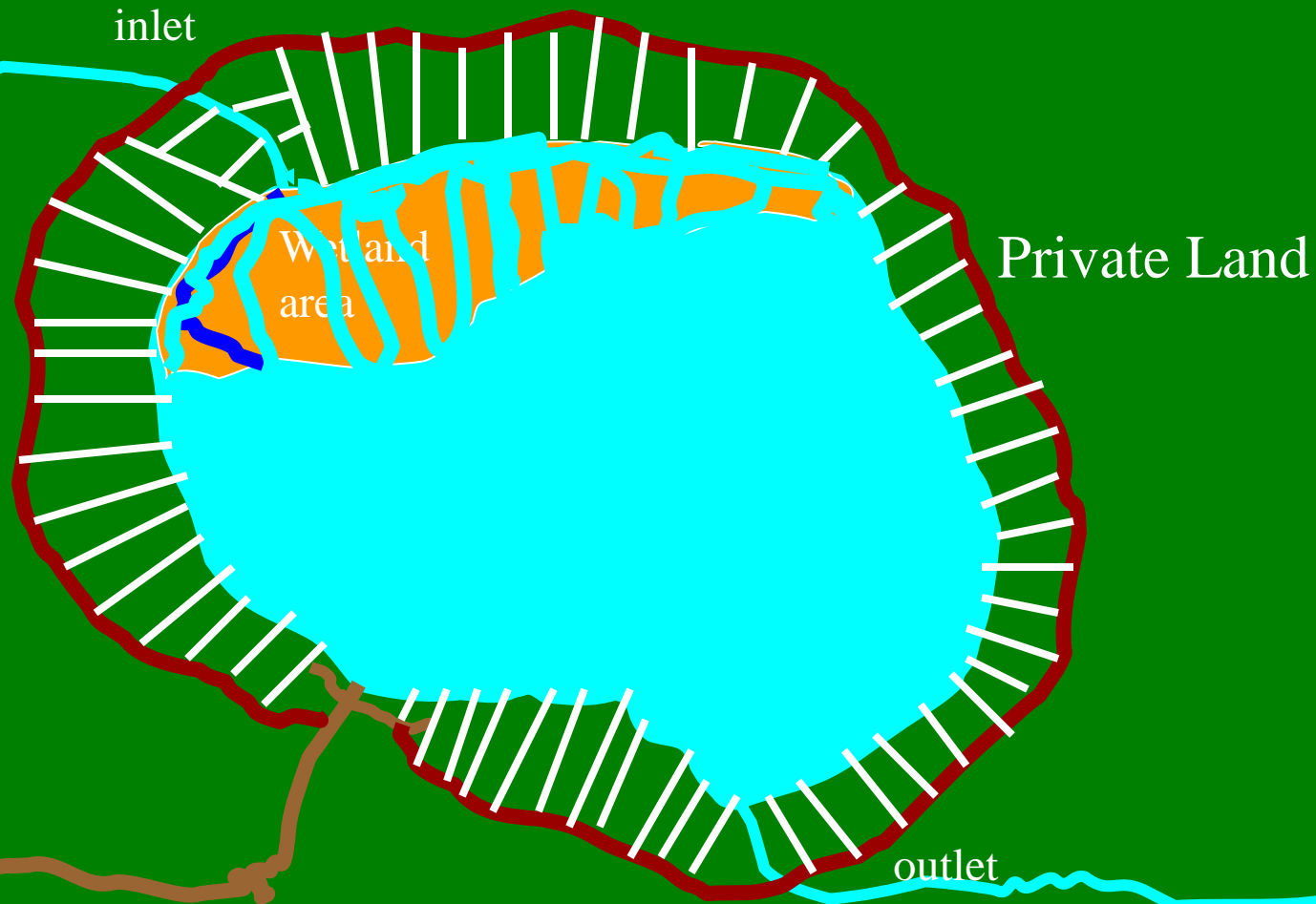

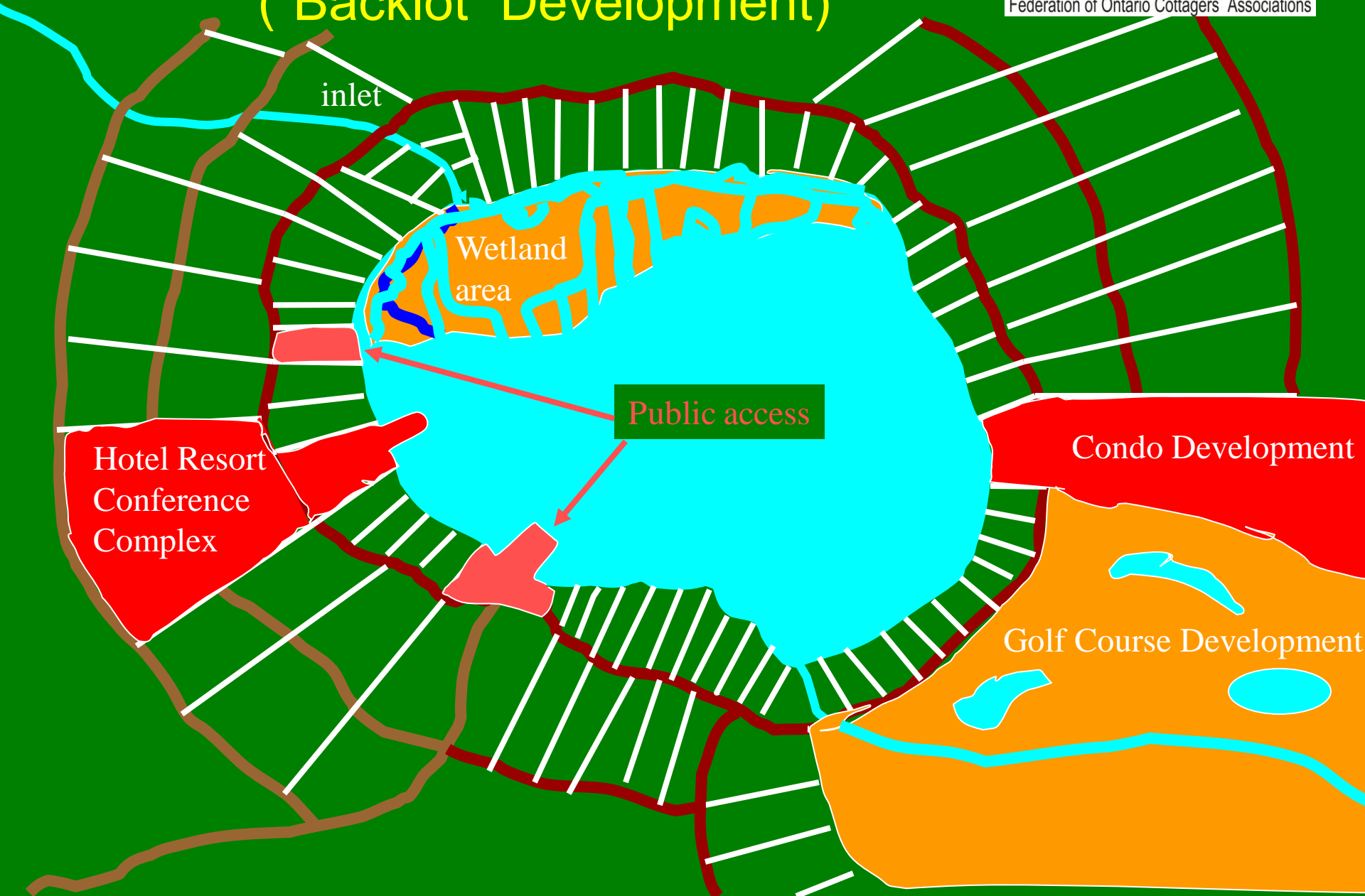
... or this
