# What are you leaving in your wake?

## What outboard motors leave in their wake is surprising.

According to Environment Canada, running an old conventional 2-stroke outboard for one minute can cause the same amount of pollution as driving a new car from Toronto to Orillia. In addition, the inefficient exhaust of an old 2-stroke releases a steady stream of unburned oil and gas directly into our waterways.

Outboards using new technology, such as 4-strokes or direct injected 2-strokes, leave a cleaner wake. These engines drastically cut emissions and decrease the amount of gas and oil that make their way into our waters. These engines consume 30-80% less gasoline, which means a reduction in fuel costs and a significant improvement in the quality of our air and water.
