

## **2022 Phragmites Control Program**

Following successful projects completed in 2021 by FOCA member Associations with Green Shovels Collaborative funding, FOCA is pleased to issue a new call for funding proposals from member Associations, for on-the-ground Projects focused on invasive Phragmites, to start this summer and to be completed by February 2023. See below for program and submission details.

## **2022 Association Projects**

FOCA seeks participation from our Member Associations across the province to run Projects addressing invasive Phragmites control at the local level. Associations will be provided funds and/or resources to conduct on-the-ground Projects focused on **Phragmites Identification**, **Control**, **Management**, **and Eradication**. Examples include:

(e.g., Contribute to research trials to test efficacy of invasive species control, purchasing equipment or technical services hire an external contractor to assist with identification, management or eradication of Phragmites.) FOCA will provide eligible Associations with funding and/or resources that will be used to carry out the Projects. **Projects may be funded up to \$4,000 for eligible expenses**.



Funding recipients will be required to submit **a final report** to FOCA, outlining project expenditures, and submitting photos and stories to demonstrate how the Project has achieved goals in the priority areas indicated on the next page. More details will be provided if your Project is selected.

FOCA will review all proposals received by July 29th, 2022 and will notify the selected associations by August 5th, 2022. Projects will be selected based on feasibility, the funds required, and whether the Project activities fall within the categories outlined above.
